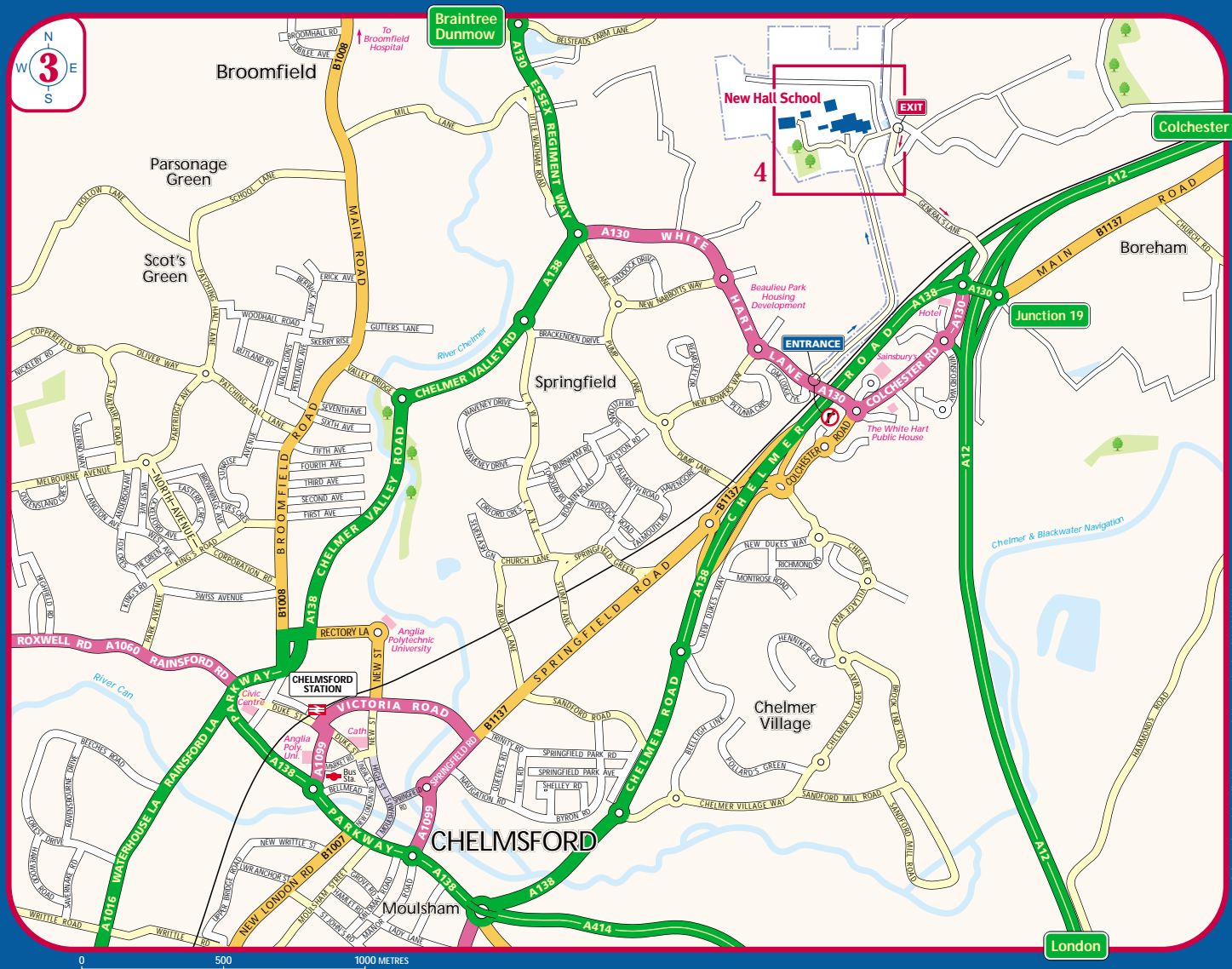
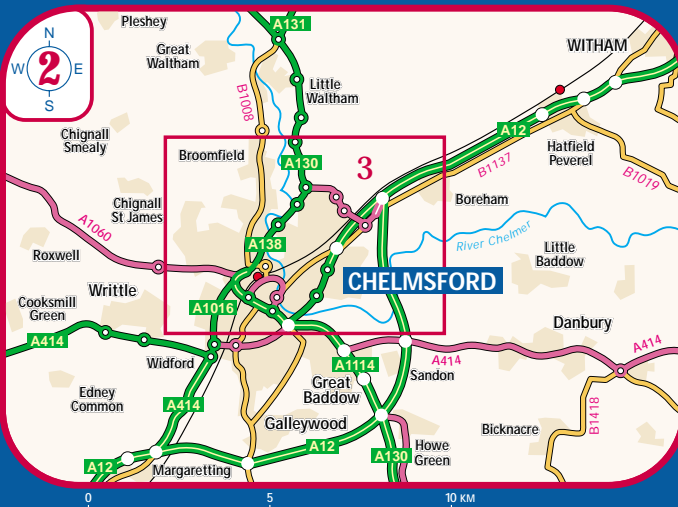
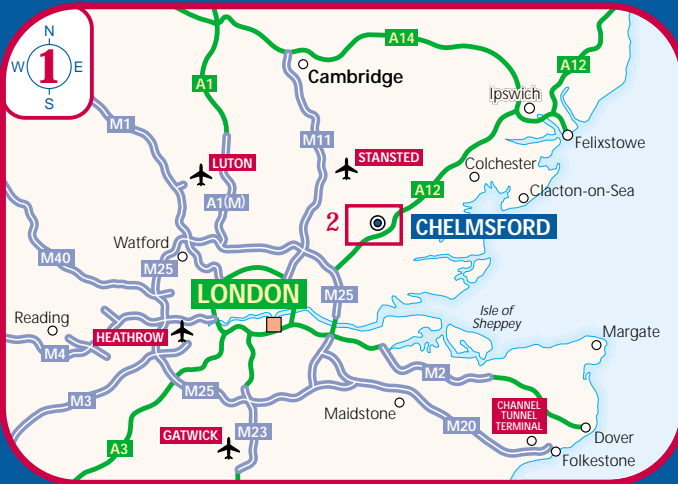


Travelling to New Hall School

By Air: The nearest airport is Stansted which is approximately a 30 minute drive, and the journey from either Heathrow or Gatwick via the M25 takes about an hour and a half.

By Rail: Trains from London depart from Liverpool Street Station roughly every 15 minutes, the journey taking approximately 30 minutes. Taxis are available from Chelmsford Station and New Hall is about a 10 minute ride.

By Road: New Hall School is situated to the northeast of Chelmsford close to the junction of the A12, A130 and A138 making it easily accessible via the UK road network.



From London & Brentwood: Follow the A12 London to Colchester road. Ignore all the turnings to Chelmsford i.e. A1016, B1007, A130 and A414. Leave the A12 at the exit signed - Chelmsford (Springfield) - Junction 19. There is also a sign for A130 - Cambridge and a local sign for the Chelmsford Cattle Market and Car Auction. At the end of the slip road, take the second exit at the roundabout towards Springfield and then take the second exit at the next roundabout (the White Hart public house is on your left and Sainsbury's Superstore is on the right). This is White Hart Lane and also the A130 to Cambridge. From this direction there is no right turn into New Hall so travel to the next roundabout and return back on yourself in order to turn left into New Hall's entrance. The entrance to New Hall School is on the left after 350 metres.

From Colchester: Follow the A12 Colchester to London road. Leave the A12 at the first exit for Chelmsford (A138) - Junction 19. From the slip road, follow the local signs for Springfield and Chelmer Village by taking the third exit from the first roundabout, at the next roundabout take the first exit and go down

the slip road to the next roundabout and travel straight over (second exit). At the next roundabout turn right (the White Hart public house is on your left and Sainsbury's Superstore is on the right). This is White Hart Lane and also the A130 to Cambridge. From this direction there is no right turn into New Hall so travel to the next roundabout and return back on yourself in order to turn left into New Hall's entrance. The entrance to New Hall School is on the left after 350 metres.

From Braintree (A131) & Dunmow (A130): At the roundabout where these two roads converge, follow the A130 towards Chelmsford. This means taking the first exit if approaching from Braintree, or going straight across if approaching from Dunmow. Continue along this road (Essex Regiment Way), going straight over the next three roundabouts. At the fourth roundabout, take the first exit (White Hart Lane) and continue to follow signs for Boreham. Within a mile, the entrance to New Hall School will be on the left, immediately after the Beaulieu Park housing development and just before the bridge over the railway.
