Administering Medication

At times, it can be difficult to contact parents when their children present with a headache or something similar, where a dose of medication may be what is required.

It would be useful, therefore, to have parental consent to administer medication in such an event so that your child would then be able to return to class and carry on with lessons. Any medication given would be recorded and details emailed to you.

May I take this opportunity to remind parents that paracetamol/ibuprofen is also a main ingredient in many common over-the-counter remedies. It is, therefore, of the utmost importance that any medication given to your child in the morning is notified to the Medical Room when your child is brought into school.
