**Class 2 Novice 80-85cm Team & Individual Qualifier**

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals.

**Class 3 Intermediate 90-95cm Team & Individual Qualifier.**

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

**Class 4 1m-1.05 Open Team & Individual Qualifier**

Single phase. All team riders automatically count as individuals

**Class 5a/b 1.10m Advanced Open Individual Qualifier**

Single phase. This class will be split into 5a) Horses, 5b) Ponies

**All team competitors will be eligible for individual placings**
