Aims:

- To explicitly link the curriculum to the co-curriculum through the scholarly habits
- To develop key character strengths in our students

- + incorporate Scholarly Habits & Character Strengths being developed

- However, at least one of the four main development aspects must be completed in school.
- The performance element must be completed as part of a school activity.

How will the award be applied?

- Bronze & Silver Awards take a minimum of 2 terms to complete. Gold takes 3 terms.
- Students would record their activities and reflections in an electronic copy of the award booklet for the appropriate level
- Students would submit completed records, via their tutor, to the Vice Principal for verification of the award
