## **Sixth Form Students Tackle Challenging Ethical and Philosophical Topics**

On 10 and 11 October, Sixth Form students at New Hall School, Boreham, participated in a two-day Human and Spiritual event, hosted by Dr Peter Vardy, a renowned lecturer and prolific author.
